Mark & Gillian Wiewel

It has been a wonderful past few weeks for us here in Prague, although not without moments of struggle too. Gillian continues to connect with other moms during her days with Oliver, especially as the sunny spring days with highs of 15° make adventures a lot more fun for Ollie. Mark's week-long winter break during February was an added bonus as it allowed for extra time as a family, time to explore Prague with colleagues, and a chance for Mark to prepare for the crunch of report cards arriving at spring break.

One of the biggest highlights at CISP (Christian International School of Prague) recently was the all-school celebration of International Mother Language Day (IMLD). This day celebrates the unique languages and cultures all of the students come from, with many of them dressing up in traditional outfits for the day. The day included activities where students from every grade teamed up to compete and learn about how languages have similarities. Some secondary students, including a few students that Mark teaches, had the chance to present and share their mother language. They shared common words, the history of their language, and compared their language's idioms to English idioms. One of the funniest Czech idioms Mark learned was "Chodit kolem horké kaše" which means "to walk around hot porridge". The English equivalent is "to beat around the bush". It was a blessing to see so many kids take pride in their home culture, show interest and respect for others' cultures, and to



praise God for how wonderfully he has made all of us. At no point was this praise more beautiful than when students led the school in singing "How Great is Our God" in languages such as Czech, French, Slovak, Hindi, and more. Seeing God worshipped in so many different languages was a great reminder of how life-changing he can be, no matter where you're from.
